Dear Parents and students,

Each year we have a mandatory school-wide Science Fair at SST-ALAMO. This year Science Fair will be held on Saturday, December 11, 2010.

This week, your child will receive a science fair package. The package provides information regarding the requirements and guidelines that need to be followed.

All School of Science and Technology students are required to prepare a Science Fair Project. The Science Fair Project is worth 200 points for 4th-8th graders. Students will also receive credit from their English, Math, Language, Computer, and Art teachers. Due to the high number of points possible for the project, grades of students who do not complete a project will be affected severely for each grading period (1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th grading periods for 4th-8th graders).

Please check the deadlines of each step of the Science Fair Project carefully. Students are highly encouraged to submit their assignments before these deadlines. This way they will have a good chance to make improvements if something is missing or needs fine tuning. Informative Science Fair Meeting for Parents (Science Fair Orientation) is scheduled as following:

- For 4-5th grade parents: Tuesday, September 21 between 5:00pm and 6:15pm.
- For 6th grade parents: Wednesday, September 22 between 5:00pm and 6:15pm.
- For 7-8th grade parents: Thursday, September 23 between 5:00pm and 6:15pm.

We will try to work with each student individually, but the ultimate responsibility belongs to students. This copy is to be kept in student's science binder. You will receive another copy of this with this week's Wednesday Mail. Please fill out that form and have your child return that sheet by Friday, September 17, to his/her science teacher.
